Art Docent: You DO NOT need to be an artist to teach! Teach art history in your child's classroom. Complete training, artwork and supplies are provided. You'll learn along with the kids. THIS IS THE ONLY ART INSTRUCTION taught at ME! Without you, there won't be art at school.

Back to School Ice Cream Social: Help with set-up, ticket sales, serving and/or clean-up.

Bingo Night: Popcorn sales, bingo board sales, announcing and crossing off numbers on overhead

Book Fair: Help with set up, take down, student shopping or man a cash register during our book fair.

Box Tops/Labels for Education: Collect, count and send in box top donations to earn a donation for our PTSA.

Carnival: Not only will your child's classroom be running a game/bouncy but we need parent volunteers to help with ticket sales, set-up/clean-up, security, info desk, sign making, etc.

Food Bank: Help collect and drop off food/donations collected in bins across school

Fund Run: Help with any of the following: sign makers, passing out Monday treats during lunches, organize T-Shirt sizing w/teachers, volunteers to wear falcon costume, design the display case, make weekly sign updates in office of total raised, help on day of fund run Friday Oct. 9th during school, etc.

Halloween Bash: Help with this great family fun night by giving some time to set up, work during the event or clean up in October.

Holiday Event: We are looking to have a NEW Holiday craft fair or event this year. We are looking for ideas and volunteers!

Recycling: Periodically collect donated ink cartridges, toiletries, and Clothes for the Cause and send off to earn donations for our PTSA.

Lunch Buddy: Serve as a positive role model and eat lunch, when needed, with a student other than your own.

Multicultural Night: Host a table to educate others about your heritage or help with set up and clean up during our annual event honoring the many cultures represented by our school's students.

Reflections: Help children with their projects after school, generally during the first trimester and help set-up and take down of their displays for the family viewing evening.

Staff Appreciation: Help with events to honor and recognize our wonderful Mukilteo Elementary staff members. This can include baking, cooking, decorating, crafting, etc.

Spelling Bee: Help judge, announce, check-in, give treats, etc. for the big night of the bee

Talent Show: A NEW EVENT this year! Help make our first show a success.

Yearbook: Help the Committee Chair take pictures of students, events, parties, etc. and/or help assemble this year's Yearbook.
